2018 Garden Plot Application and Agreement

Each garden plot is a 4' x 8' raised bed, available for a fee for \$35. The fee covers use of bed through the 2018 growing season (May 1 through November 1, 2018) and includes water access, annual maintenance and project fees. Financial assistance is available. *Garden plots are limited and will be filled on a first come, first serve basis – apply early! Garden Guidelines

- Pay a fee of **\$35** per garden season for each plot. Additional plots may be available based upon availability as of June 1st.
- Each gardener must participate in the annual fall garden cleanup.
- Have the plot planted by June 1st and maintain the plot for the entire garden season. Otherwise, it will be reassigned.
- The assigned plot and surrounding areas need to be kept free of weeds and kept clean.
- Pack It In - Pack It Out! Trash receptacles are not provided. Trash and litter needs to be removed from the plot, as well as from adjacent pathways and fences.
- Corn, sunflowers and other tall crops are only allowed if they do not shade neighboring plots.
- Gardeners will pick only their own crops unless given permission by another plot user. Produce must be harvested regularly to avoid over- ripened fruits/veggies, which attracts unwanted pests.
- Theft of or damage to any part of the garden or garden equipment will not be permitted.
- Only natural fertilizers and amendments are allowed. Synthetic or chemical pesticides, herbicides, or insecticides are not allowed. Our goal is to be an organic garden. Please use amendments certified for organic agriculture.

Enchanted Valley Community Garden

- Plots need to be put to bed for the winter by Nov. 1st by mulching or planting a cover crop.
- Please closely supervise your children. Pets are not allowed within the fenced area, but can be tethered outside.
- Smoking and consumption of alcohol on garden property is not allowed.
- Produce from the garden cannot be sold for profit.
- Garden equipment (tools, wheelbarrow, hoses, etc.) need to be cleaned and put away after each use.
- All gardening activity (digging, weeding, etc.) and plant growth must be limited to your assigned garden plot.
- Invasive plants, large structures, illegal plants, tall bushes or trees are not allowed.
- Unwanted plant material from the plot needs to be composted. No invasive plants or weed seeds should be placed in the compost pile, but must be taken away by gardener.
- Any grievances should be reported to Wenatchee River Institute for resolution.
- Wenatchee River Institute reserves the right to make amendments to these Policies and Rules at any time.

I understand that these guidelines are put in place for my safety and protection, along with my fellow gardeners. I will follow the rules and understand that any violation of the above guidelines is grounds for losing my plot. I understand that neither the garden group nor owners of the land are responsible for my actions. I THEREFORE AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS THE GARDEN GROUP, WENATCHEE RIVER INSTITUTE, AND OWNERS OF THE LAND FOR ANY LIABILITY, DAMAGE, LOSS OR CLAIM THAT OCCURS IN CONNECTION WITH USE OF THE GARDEN BY ME OR ANY OF MY GUESTS.
