1. Can fly in any direction it wants, including backwards.

2. Can swivel their heads more than 180 degrees to hunt prey.

3. Sings "cheeseburger" to mark its territory or to attract a mate.

4. Forms flocks known as coveys in fall and winter to protect themselves from predators.

5. Prefers to live close to people to scavenge for food.

6. Have tongues twice the length of their bill so that they can reach for insects inside the holes they peck out.

7. Migrates to places where it is warmer and where food is available by flying overhead in a V-formation.
