	Rubus discolor	Himalayan blackberry	Invader	Cut out canes. Remove root ball.
	Polygonum cuspidatum	Japanese knotweed	Invader	Pull, remove all roots.
	Centaurea diffusa	Diffuse knapweed	Noxious invader	Dig rosettes, pull bolted plants, bag and put in trash. Introduce one of several specific insects for biological control.
	Linaria genistofolia	Dalmation toadflax	Noxious invader	Pull all plants and roots. Release specific insects for biological control. Plant competitive native plants.
	Tragopogon dubius	Salsify	Vigorous invader	Invades disturbed sites, becoming more prevalent. Will bloom even after being pulled so pick off flowers and bugs and bag.
	Cytisus scoparius	Scotch broom	Invader	Pull all plants and roots.

	Acer glabrum	Douglas maple	Native	Drought-tolerant maple, small tree.

	Betula pendula	Weeping birch	Ornamental	
	Crataegus douglasii	Douglas hawthorn	Native	Thorns. Cover/fruit for birds. Butterfly (caterpillar food).
	Fraxinus sp.	Ash	Ornamental	
	Pinus ponderosa	Ponderosa pine	Native	Accustomed to dry climate, fire- adapted (thick bark).

	Pinus sylvestris	Scots pine	Introduced	Cultivated for windbreaks, timber, and Christmas trees.
	Populus tremuloides	Quaking aspen	Native	Great wildlife tree. Many Native American uses. Aspen is on the decline nation-wide.

Rhus radicans	Poison ivy	Native	POISONOUS. Oils in the leaves cause itching and burning if contacted. "Leaflets 3, let it be."
Rosa nutkana	Nootka rose	Native	Good cover. Butterfly (caterpillar) food plant.
Rosa woodsii	Wood's rose	Native	Good cover. Drought tolerant. Butterfly (caterpillar) food plant.
Salix sp.	Willow	Native	Butterfly (caterpillar) food plant.
Sambucus cerulea	Blue elderberry	Native	Deer love it. Native Americans used. Fruit makes good jelly.
Symphoricarpus albus	Snowberry	Native	White berries.
